Biographical Sketch

The following collection concerns the Clark family. Please see the biographical sketches for a more detailed outline of their genealogy. Names shown in bold appear in this collection.

Andrew Dalrymple (1723 – 1803) serves as the first ancestor of the Clark family in this collection. Appearing only in Series IV: Legal Documents, as the purchaser and seller of various parcels of land, the majority of materials adhere to British government regulations.

Occasionally, Dalrymple entered indenture agreements and also appears in several court summons in Colerain, Franklin County, Massachusetts, where he spent the majority of his life.

In 1757, he married Anna Clapp Winslow (1739 – 1803) and had two children, including Mary

“Molly” Dalrymple (1760 – 1845) and Anna Dalrymple (1773 – 1862). On the dates of December 1776, April – May 1777, and August 1780 he served as a private in the 3rd Worcester Company Regiment in the American Revolution. Andrew Dalrymple is buried in the North River Cemetery in Colrain, Massachusetts.

Andrew Dalrymple’s eldest daughter, Mary “Molly” Dalrymple, married John Clark (1764 –1835) in 1789. Their children included John Lyman Clark, Sr. (1798 – 1865), who appears in this collection, and Andrew Lewis Clark (1800 - 1863).

John Lyman Clark, Sr. worked as a farmer in the town of Colerain, Mass. for the majority of his life. He married Almira (Shattuck) Clark on September 16, 1821, and had several children. Materials relating to his sons Lewis Clark (1822 – 1865) and John Lyman Clark, Jr. (1840-1904) serve as the bulk of this collection. The significant age difference between Lewis and John Lyman Clark, Jr., must be noted, and the almost paternal relationship between the two men is evident in their letters. Clark, Sr. and his sons also bought, sold, and traded horses, with correspondence spanning Illinois, New Hampshire, Vermont, and Michigan. Broadsides advertising this business can be found in this collection. The bulk of the correspondence are letters addressed to Lewis Clark, written by his brother John Lyman Clark, Jr., his sister Mary (Clark) Taylor (1825 – 1909) and his brother-in-law, Jonathan M. Taylor, concerning their business, land, and family news. Census records reveal that the Clark family lived in close proximity, and even the same residence, as multiple family members pen several letters written to Lewis Clark.

Not much is known about Lewis Clark, as he does not author any letters. Many of the educational materials, however, bear his name and childhood work, including an illustration of a horse. His name also appears on the bulk of invitations found in this collection, and his wife’s name is believed to be Anna.

John Lyman Clark, Jr. married Nancy Elizabeth “Lizzie” (Miller) Clark (1839 –1897) on November 26, 1865, and worked his father’s farm for the majority of his life. He authors the majority of correspondence, business receipts, and the bulk of educational materials pertain to his childhood. Although he did not serve, in 1863 his name appeared in the Civil War Draft registration, listed as “farmer, unmarried,” with the only remark being “feeble.” He had several children, the descendants of whom appear in the photographs and school programs in this collection. His wife, Lizzie Clark, worked as a teacher for the majority of her life, her teaching certificates also included in these papers. Notably, while a student, Lizzie Clark served as the editor for a newsletter titled “The Evening Star”, including poetry, essays, jokes, and articles all authored by women. These hand-bound and hand-written newsletters offer fascinating insight into the minds of 19th century women. Her daughter, Mary B. Clark (1877 –) also worked a teacher. John Lyman Clark, Sr., Almira Clark, John Lyman Clark, Jr., and Lizzie Clark are all buried in the North River Cemetery in Colrain, Massachusetts.

Scope and Content

The Clark Family Papers consist of a wide variety of material, including photographs, correspondence, business receipts, bills, account pages, legal documents, printed materials, poems, essays, hair art, drawings, formulas, calling cards, invitations, and programs. The bulk of the correspondence is addressed to Lewis Clark, while the majority of the legal documents

pertain to Andrew Dalrymple and John L. Clark Jr. The first four series are organized chronologically, while the final series is organized thematically due to the variety of material.
